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Skid Car

The Skid Car is the perfect way to learn what causes a vehicle to skid and indeed how to avoid them. The Skid Car, unlike the Skid Pan, can replicate a variety of road surfaces from wet to ice and from snow to aquaplaning. All drivers will learn at their own pace under the watchful and experienced eye of our trainers, learning in a fun and safe environment. This is an invaluable life skill for all drivers and provides the knowledge to 'Recognise & Avoid' skids in the future.
