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Training

- Identification of areas of danger within sites

- This course will raise awareness of the dangers caused when reversing
- Learn practical techniques and hand signals to assist drivers in this manoeuvre

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Practical Training – 45 Minutes

Trainees and trainer will carry out all practical learning from the above seminar and put into practice, in a controlled and safe environment all of the lessons learnt.

The trainer will give a short demonstration in order to illustrate the benefits and application of the recognised safe and clear signals including all H&S to trainees and in turn will ask the trainees to perform various manoeuvres, with group input.

- A suitable vehicle and manoeuvring area will be required to conduct this session.
