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Detail

The course proposed is a half day in duration, 1.5hrs per driver assessment and begins with a briefing. The driving licence and eye-sight of the trainee will be checked and then the driver will be assessed on their vehicle checking, driving and vehicle Manoeuvring skills. A brief report of the training will be issued to the line manager or responsible person. If our trainer identifies any concerns, RED will advise further driving training should be completed.

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Assessment

On Road

Following the briefing the course will commence with an eyesight and vehicle check. Following this the trainee will then drive for the remainder of the session covering the below;

- Assessing the pre drive checks completed by the driver
- Assessing the driver's expertise in managing the high-risk environment of urban driving and reducing the likelihood of being involved in a preventable driving incident
- Assessing the ability to manoeuvre the vehicle under control and safely.

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Who Is This For?



Any drivers who require an initial or refresher driving assessment



Any new driver or a driver who is using an unfamiliar vehicle, example a driver moving up from a car to a van (LCV) and requires assessment in the vehicle.



Any newly qualified driver in any licence category

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Outcome



A brief report will be produced post assessment for the Manager, this will indicate the professional trainer's independent assessment of the driving skills level of the trainee.

No certification is provided for the assessment.
